
#### IT'S OFFICIAL! NEW SUBURBS TO JOIN COWAN




## **GRANTS UPDATE**

My office has been busy working with the community this year to administer grant programs.

This year over \$350,000 has been approved for 58 Cowan community groups!

There were so many more worthy project applications and it's always exciting to see the work being done in the community!



### POWERING COMMUNITIES

Nearly \$70,000

This program helps not-for-profit organisations become more energy efficient.

Some of the groups that have been assessed for funding include Fostering Hope, RSPCA WA, Sacred India Gallery, and the Northern Suburbs Men's Shed.

## STRONGER COMMUNITIES

\$150,000

This program funds small capital projects to improve local community participation and contributes to the livelihood and vibrancy in communities.

Some of the groups that have received funding include **No Limits Perth, Marangaroo Family Centre,** and the **Perth North Tamil School.** 

#### **VOLUNTEER GRANTS**

Over \$130,000

This program supports not-for-profit organisations to support the volunteers in their group, for example, funding can be used to assist with training courses or equipment. Some of the groups that have been approved for funding include **Grandparents Rearing Grandchildren**, **Macedonian Community of WA**, and **The Pantry WA**.

# Labor's plan for a **National Anti-Corruption Commission**


- Investigate Commonwealth ministers, parliamentarians, personal staff, and other Commonwealth public officials.
- Carry out its functions independently of government. With the Commissioner and any Deputy Commissioner serving a tenure comparable to a federal judge.
- Have the power to investigate allegations of serious and systemic corruption that occurred before or after its establishment.
- Overseen by a statutory bipartisan Joint Standing Committee of the Parliament, empowered to require the Commission to provide information about its work.

### **COVID-19 UPDATE**

This year Scott Morrison had two jobs, the vaccine rollout and effective quarantine.

Scott Morrison said it's not a race - he's wrong.

Australia's COVID vaccine rollout is far behind other nations and hotel quarantine is not fit for purpose. The vaccine program is ranked 36 out of the 38 OECD countries, and there have been at least 27 leaks from hotel quarantine causing lockdowns and tragic deaths.

The Morrison Government is responsible for both but it's clear that Scott Morrison has botched the rollout and won't take responsibility for quarantine.

## Labor's plan to beat COVID-19

- Build quarantine facilities across the country, with at least one in every state.
- Fix the vaccine rollout.
- Have an effective mass information campaign.
- Begin manufacturing mRNA vaccines, like Pfizer, right here in Australia.
